***Veolia Transportation Wins Greensboro Transit Contract Renewal
Greensboro City Council Vote is Unanimous***

Greensboro, NC – April 30, 2009 – Eastern Region Vice President Ken Westbrook announced today that Veolia Transportation will continue to operate service for the Greensboro Transit Authority (GTA) for another five years. The City of Greensboro city council voted 9-0 in favor of the renewal at their monthly meeting on Tuesday, April 21, 2009.

In announcing the decision regarding the award, GTA's Director of Transportation, Adam Fischer acknowledged Veolia Transportation was not the lowest bidder. The decision, Fischer indicated, was made based on the company's long history of service operation in the City of Greensboro and their high level of excellence and achievement.

Following the meeting, Westbrook said of the decision, "We are delighted to be able to continue to support the Greensboro Transit Authority in their mission to provide top quality mobility services. We greatly value our partnership with the GTA. We are grateful to our General Manager Nancy Nichols and her hard-working management team for their track record of excellent performance."

The renewal, which takes affect July 1, 2009, has a three year base with two (1) year options. The fleet of 120 vehicles provides service for fixed route, paratransit, flex services and college shuttles. Veolia Transportation has operated the GTA service under contract with the City of Greensboro since 1999.
