

Transdev Awarded Contract Extension in Antelope Valley, CA

Lancaster, CA – October 1, 2015 – The Antelope Valley Transit Authority Board of Directors awarded a two-year extension to its existing contract with Transdev on August 25, 2015. Transdev provides fixed route bus and commuter bus services for 3.4 million passengers annually in Antelope Valley, located in the Los Angeles Basin. Transdev has proudly operated the AVTA transit system since 2006.

Transdev provides operations and maintenance services for the AVTA system, utilizing 76 vehicles and 184 employees to operate its 17 bus routes.

We applaud AVTA's dedication to the community's air quality through its plans to move toward a fully electric fleet. Currently, the system has two 100% electric buses in its fleet, but will have twenty-nine within the next three years.
