***Transdev North America Promotes Mike Murray to President and
COO of Transit Division***

Lombard, IL – September 10, 2014 – Transdev CEO, Mark Joseph, announced that Mike Murray has been promoted to President and Chief Operating Officer of the company’s Transit Division. The promotion is effective October 1, 2014. He will take the place of Ken Westbrook, who was recently promoted to Chairman of the Transit Division. Murray previously served as Senior Vice-President.

In his new role, Murray will work with the company’s senior management team to continue its growth as the largest private-sector operator of multiple modes of transit. Prior to joining Transdev, Murray served as President and CEO of FirstGroup America, which included First Student, First Transit, First Vehicle Services, First Services, First Mobile Technologies and Greyhound Lines. He was responsible for revenues of \$5 billion and nearly 100,000 employees in the U.S. and Canada. Murray practiced corporate, labor and employment law in both the trucking and passenger transportation industries. His academic history includes a Bachelor’s degree in Political Science, a Master’s Degree in Labor and Human Resources, and a Law Degree.
