Veolia Transportation Promotes Maurice Bell to GM in Dallas, Texas

Dallas, TX – September 29, 2009 – Veolia Transportation has promoted Assistant General Manager Maurice Bell to General Manager for their Dallas Paratransit operation. The announcement was made by Area Vice President Chris Langmayer and is effective immediately.

As General Manager Bell will be responsible for direct oversight of the operations of 400 employees, annual budget, and cost control as well as serve as the primary contact with the client, Dallas Area Rapid Transit Paratransit & Innovative Services (DART).

“Maurice was a natural choice for the General Manager’s position,” said Langmayer. “As Assistant GM for the past six years he’s been responsible for much of the day to day operations and is very knowledgeable about this service.”

While there, Bell was responsible for assisting in the statistical tracking and billing of the \$7.5 million annual budget and daily monitoring of all operational issues related to the contract’s 200 employees and 100 vehicle fleet.

Bell earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in Business Management from American Intercontinental University. In addition he holds a certificate in Paratransit/Transit Management from the University of the Pacific in Stockton, California and a certificate in Contemporary Management Practices / Financial Management from University of California Davis.
